Minimum Standard Health Protocol Guidelines from Texas Governor Abbott

- Please note these guidelines were taken from the Texas Education Agency
- Masks will be required by ALL staff
- **ALL STAFF and CAMPERS will be required to take the Health Questionnaire DAILY in order to be on campus at CML.**
- Every staff member and camper will be scanned daily with a non-touch scan thermometer. Anyone with a temperature over 99.1 will not be permitted on campus.
- **IF YOUR CHILD HAS THE FOLLOWING SYMPTOMS: COUGH, RUNNY NOSE, SNEEZING THEY MAY NOT ATTEND CAMP. WE ASK THAT THEY BE SYMPTOM FREE FOR 24 HOURS BEFORE RETURNING TO CML. IF YOUR CHILD SHOWS THESE SYMPTOMS WHILE AT CAMP, WE WILL CALL PARENTS TO PICK THEM UP.**
- If a sibling stays home due to illness, we ask that all children within the family attending camp STAY HOME. No child may return unless they are 24 hours symptom free of any illness.
- No parents or guardians visiting the camp during or between camp sessions, except to drop off and pick up campers using the carpool line procedures.
- Campers with their Counselors will remain consistent during each week session. Mixing the groups will be within age groups only.
- Each room will have hand sanitizer, disinfectant wipes, soap and water, and hospital cleaner which will be used throughout the day in each room. Hand washing will be done before and after each activity.
- Snacks and lunches will be served in the classroom for each age group.
- We cannot expect toddlers or Preschoolers to not engage in interactive play. However, our groups will consist of 10 campers per Teacher allowing plenty of room to play in each classroom.
